ENTRY FORM OVERLEAF

Conditions of Entry

1. The tournament is conducted under the Tournament Conditions of the Portarlington Golf Club Inc.
 2. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Ltd. and The United States Golf Association, together with such Local Rules as are in force at the Club.
 3. The tournament is open to men and ladies holding an Australian handicap gained as a member of a golf club affiliated with the AGU and Golf Access members who have a current handicap. Note: A Callaway event may be run for those Sponsors or their Representatives who do not have an official handicap
 4. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the full entry fee.
 5. No refunds will apply where scratching is received after the closing date.
 6. Dress requirements are neat casual in the Clubhouse and on the Course. Soft spikes are preferred.
 6. All disputes and all issues related to the conduct of the event will be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition whose decision shall be final.
 7. In the event of a tie, a result shall be decided using the Count Back system as laid down by the AGU and the WGA.
 8. No player is eligible to win more than one major trophy.
 9. Competitors are Honorary Members of the Portarlington Golf Club Inc for the duration of the competition.
 10. Golf carts are permitted and can be hired through the Pro Shop on 52593361. Hire push buggies are also available.
 11. If insufficient entries are received, the committee has the right to cancel or vary the event or part thereof.
 12. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Committee may cancel, shorten or postpone the competition to another day.
 13. The Committee Reserves the right to set the grades.
 14. Team Event winner(s) shall be determined by the aggregate of the three best of the four team scores returned.
- Note: Players must compete to be eligible for the teams trophy.
